The following information is made a part of this RFP (Deletions are shown as ~~strike-throughs~~ and additions/ revised text are shown in **blue):**

1. RFP Section 3.2 In-Lane System Functional Requirements – delete:

~~“Travel lanes and shoulder lanes that are 10 feet wide or greater will be fully equipped, shoulder lanes that are greater than four feet wide and less than 10 feet wide will have limited equipment, and shoulder lanes less than four feet wide will not be equipped.”~~

and replace with the following:

“Travel lanes and shoulder lanes that are 10 feet wide or greater will be fully equipped, shoulder lanes that are greater than or equal to four feet wide and less than 10 feet wide will have limited equipment, and shoulder lanes less than four feet wide will not be equipped.”

2. RFP Section 3.2.2 Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) – delete:

~~“The TSI Contractor shall furnish UPSs that are compatible with portable generators that will be mounted in the cabinet(s) to allow connectivity with no tools required.”~~

and replace with the following:

“The TSI Contractor shall furnish UPSs to be mounted in cabinets that are compatible with portable generators to allow connectivity with no tools required.”

3. RFP Section 3.2.5 Violation Enforcement System – delete 7th bullet point:

~~“Images shall be stored in native format for OCR and VSR processing for a configurable rolling period of not less than thirty (30) days at the roadside or hub location and shall allow for automatic rebroadcast, and re-OCR and re-VSR as necessary;”~~

and replace with the following:

“Images shall be stored in a format which supports OCR and VSR processing for a configurable rolling period of not less than thirty (30) days at the roadside or hub location and shall allow for automatic rebroadcast, and re-OCR and re-VSR as necessary;”

- 4. RFP Section 4.5.4 Compliance with Installation Standards – delete:

~~“The TSI Contractor shall adhere to all installation standards, applicable laws, ordinances, and codes as specified in GDOT Special Provisions and IEEE and NEC standards.”~~

and replace with the following:

“The TSI Contractor shall adhere to all installation standards, applicable laws, ordinances, and codes as specified in IEEE and NEC standards, GDOT Standards and Details, GDOT Standard Specifications, and GDOT Special Provisions. The TSI Contractor shall adhere to installation requirements detailed in the Special Provisions incorporated as part of the GDOT RFPs.”

- 5. RFP Section 5.4.5 Training Facility – delete:

~~“Should it be determined that certain aspects would be better addressed on location,”~~

and replace with the following:

“Should it be determined by SRTA through coordination with the TSI Contractor that certain aspects would be better addressed on location;”

- 6. Appendix L, Price Proposal Worksheet is deleted in its entirety and replaced with Appendix L, Price Proposal Addendum 4 dated 07/09/13. The updated Appendix L may be downloaded from the ftp site, Official Procurement Documents/Addendum #4 folder, which shall be used for the TSI response. Revisions are summarized on the tab entitled, “Addendum 4 – CHANGES”.
